TURING TAP

A popular pub that can be found between the university campus and the hospital. Named after mathematician Alan Turing, who worked as a code breaker in World War II and worked in Manchester with the university on one of the world's first computers.

WHITWORTH PARK HALLS

Whitworth Park hall of residence is centrally located on the University of Manchester campus, close to the main buildings and Students' Union. The site comprises of eight buildings where students live in flats with 7-9 people. There is also a bar, gym and music room available for residents.

DEAF INSTITUTE

The cathedral is located on Victoria Street and provides events as well as opportunities for worship. The tower is 135ft high and the building required significant restoration in the Victorian period and after World War II.

WHITWORTH HALL ARCH

The ceremonial Whitworth Hall was built between 1898 and 1902 to commemorate the Manchester engineer Joseph Whitworth. This building is one of the main landmarks on campus, with students graduating in the hall and taking those famous photos under the archway.

THE OLD QUAD

The Old Quad is the oldest part of the university and is located through the Whitworth arch, with paths leading to the Alan Gilbert Learning Commons and the Main Library. The John Beyer building originally housed all subjects except Chemistry and Medicine.
